Vox Men's Retreat FAQ's

1. What does the cost of the retreat cover?

Camp Hume charges each individual for two overnight stays in their lodge, 5 meals, use of facilities and property, and staffing of activities. Vox Church incurs a few expenses as well in order to promote and run the weekend.

2. If I can't afford the entire cost, are there scholarships available?

Yes. Click on "fill out this application" under Financial Aid and fill out your request form and someone from your campus will get back to you within 24 hours.

3. Who is the retreat for?

The retreat is for guys who have graduated high school on up. Feel free to invite your neighbors, friends, and family members as well.

4. What time should I arrive?

Arrival time on Friday night is between 5:30-6:30 pm. There will be a table set up when you pull up where you will check-in and receive room assignments. Be sure to eat dinner **before** you arrive!

5. What if I need to arrive later than the registration time?

No problem. Park and find the group (based on the schedule) and check-in with a leader.

6. Who do I put down for a roommate preference?

If you would like to room with a friend, a family member, or someone from your Vox location, write their name down when your register. If you don't have anyone to write down, that's ok, you will be assigned a room. We will do our best to put people together in similar age groups.

7. What will we be doing at the retreat?

The schedule of the retreat is attached to the bottom of this document. Also, each man will be receiving a booklet for the weekend. In the booklet, there will be a schedule, devotions for Saturday and Sunday morning, as well as places to take notes during the sessions and workshops.

8. What should I bring?

A "what to bring" list will be sent out two weeks before the retreat.

9. Will there be a lot of walking?

The short answer is "as much as you would like to." There are plenty of opportunities for you to sit, relax, and enjoy downtime. There will also be plenty of activities you can participate in as well. It's up to you how much walking you want to do.

10. What if I have food allergies?
