

HANG TIGHT

Scholars debate on the time it took in between the Lord giving this promise to Noah that a flood will in fact come, to the actual event of the flood itself... They say it took between 55-120 years for the promise to come to fruition. Let's be honest, either way, that is an extremely long time for Noah to remain faithful to what the Lord said. I'm sure there were people around him that thought he was absolutely crazy for building a giant boat in the midst of a dry season. I would guess that doubt rose in his mind about what the Lord had said and he questioned whether or not he heard His great voice correctly. Yet, for 55-120 years he held tight to the promise of God and acted on what He had said.

The Lord has given me quite a few prophetic pictures and promises about my future. There are days when I am not even shaken by the discouragements others may bring up to me, but there are other days where I can sway and forget the promises the Lord has placed in my hands. A dear friend gave me a word from the Lord recently on this topic, she believed the Lord was encouraging me to "Hang tight."

Hang tight to these promises that I could easily forget or think are not from Him. Hang tight to the faithfulness of the Lord in my life. Hang tight to the signs that will come forth that make way for the coming promises. When you see signs of your promise, even if they seem insignificant, charge ahead towards Him! God is standing in your promises saying, "Come here! I'm right here, waiting for you."

(See verse 4) Abel's sacrifice was pleasing to God because it was done by faith. Think about this: the offering of your life can only be done in and by faith. Are you striving and struggling to please God by your own efforts? Today, take your eyes off your own successes or failures. Fix your gaze completely on Jesus. Choose total dependence upon God. Surrender your life by faith. Receive His love and acceptance to you. Now, write a prayer of surrender and thanksgiving to God.

(Verse 6) It's impossible to please God apart from faith. Why? Because to approach Him we must both believe He exists and that He cares enough to respond.

This means it's possible to live a life pleasing to God. And this God-pleasing life isn't about being the strongest, smartest, or best-looking person around.

It's about simply believing in Jesus His life, death, resurrection and His great love for you. And that's possible for everyone.

V LEGACY

Legacy. What comes to mind when you hear that word? Do you picture a will being read? Anestate being divided? Money, homes, even Grandma's good china being passed down to children and grandchildren? Those are all good things, things that should be received with open hands and grateful hearts. But there's more to legacy than temporal gain. Verse 2 of our scripture focus today speaks of a testimony of faith. Someone once put it this way: it was for this kind of faith that men and women of old received their divine commendation, and this has been placed on permanent record as an example to their descendants. Regardless of your financial worth, you can leave behind a rich spiritual legacy that will outlast every temporal blessing known to man. It's called a heritage of faith.

This promise of legacy became very personal for me in August 2016. I was in Cape Cod (my favorite place!), on vacation with my husband Joe, our 3 adult children and our soon-to-be daughter-in-law. That was the summer of Hebrews 11 for me. I was wrestling through some unexpected family loss and personal change. Suddenly, in verse 2 this concept of legacy came alive for me. For by it (faith) the people of old received their commendation. Commendation, what does that mean? It means to bear an honorable testimony. "Hmmm...ok, God." It was then I heard the Spirit of God say, You and Joe are leaving a heritage of faith for your children. Honestly, these words took my breath away. My eyes began to open to the reality of leaving behind eternal riches for our children. God spoke to me as if it was a present truth; something that already existed. You and Joe are leaving a heritage of faith for your children. Heritage speaks of property that descends to an heir. It's something that is transmitted or possessed as a result of your birth. I began to see and believe this incredible promise from God. Our children, their children, their children's children (you get my point) will live their lives with solid conviction and absolute reliance upon Christ. Bred into their bones is gospel faith that changes everything. By the grace of God, they will live their lives on the secure foundation of faith

I wish I could say that this legacy was a result of our incredible, faultless journey these past 30 years. But that would be a lie. As I sat there that day, very aware of my shortcomings and a few of Joe's (he only has one or two). I was reminded of something simple but profound. This legacy comes by placing your faith in God. It had nothing to do with our righteousness. It was purchased by the cross of Jesus Christ and is freely available to all who will turn to Him in faith. As a follower of Jesus, this inheritance is mine by faith. Then, the Lord took me a step further in this truth. And as we follow the Lord fully, like Caleb (see Numbers 14:24), our descendants will also possess this priceless treasure.

There it was. A truth I could grab hold of with both hands or shrink back from in doubt. I grabbed it! I believed it! I started to reflect on the years of marriage and of parenting. I began to see a common theme. That theme was faith.

My husband loe is an incredible man. As a husband, father and best friend, I

couldn't find anyone better. But above all, he is a man of unwavering faith. It's

been that faith that we've lived in for almost 30 years now. It's been that faith that we've raised our kids in. And it's thatfaith that they now, as adults, own.

So, how did it happen? What did it look like? As I reflect, I realize legacy wasn't built by grand gestures of faith. It's always been simple faith brought into every aspect of life. It happened in the morning getting ready for school and work, in the afternoon when the school bus arrived and then at the dinner table together. It happened in the times of plenty, and in the times of lack; in the laughter and in the tears; in the births and in the deaths; in the mundane and in the unexpected. It happened in the growing up and in the growing old. Every season and every circumstance faced with the deep and solid persuasion that God is real. That He is good, that He never leaves us, and that He always provides.

2017 was a big year for the Silva family. Our son, Joey married the love of his life, Chrissy. Our oldest daughter, Meghan, graduated from college. And our youngest, Caity, married her high school sweetheart, Will. We watch, in wonder and gratitude as they build their lives on the firm foundation of faith in Jesus. As they live in a way that says God is real and deeply cares about every aspect of my life. I'm convinced it was simple faith that has created this heritage of faith.

This is what we pass on to our children.

A secure testimony.

A divine and eternal legacy.

Faith.

Abraham is the main character in this week's passage.

Throughout his life, Abraham acted as a man who walked by faith not by sight. Abraham teaches us that faith and obedience are inseparable in our relationship with God.

Obedience is truly the outward evidence of inward faith.

Acts of obedience are not always easy. They require a faith that rests not on the basis of knowing all the facts and details, but on the expectation of things to come on the goodness of the God who calls us.

This type of faith considers that the promise of God is as substantial as its realization.

The secret is found in verse 10. Abraham was looking for a city of a different kind. One with eternal foundations. One that was planned and built by God.

THE AMPLIFIED VERSION (AMP)

Moses' life is marked by a faith that makes risky choices. It started with his parents. When he was a baby, they recognized a divine favor on Moses and defied a decree ordering that all male Israelite children would be put to death at birth. As an adult, Moses renounces the status he enjoyed as a member of the Egyptian royal family and chooses, by faith, to identify himself with the enslaved Israelites. Verse 26 tells us that he decides that the stigma and disrepute of Christ is far more valuable than the treasures of this world.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE MEMORIZATION

5 HE REGARDED DISGRACE FOR THE SAKE OF CHRIST AS OF GREATER VALUE THAN THE TREASURES OF EGYPT BECAUSE HE WAS LOOKING AHEAD TO HIS REWARD. His faith required action.

You may not realize it but every believer in Christ will be faced with the same type of choice that Moses faced. You may not be forced to leave a royal family, forsake a position of great authority and prestige or walk away from great wealth. But as we choose to follow Christ, each of us will face choices that by the world's standards will seem foolish. Maybe for you, it's breaking up with that perfect guy because you know the relationship does not honor Christ. Or leaving that dream job because you sense God calling you onto the mission field. Maybe it's forgiving that friend who betrayed you. Or giving that money you saved for a new car to feed the poor. The list is endless. But the reality for all of us is the same. God desires that your life would be so marked by His Presence and His Power, that you would live in believing obedience to His Word.

Today, you will be reading the Old Testament account of Hebrews 11:29.

In this story, found in Exodus 14, we see God's saving power on behalf of His people. This exodus from Egypt,

though a real, historical event, points to the saving work of Christ on our behalf. The passing through the Red

sea is symbolic of the believer's identification found in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

As you read this chapter from Exodus, keep in mind your spiritual journey from death to life.

TIME IN SURRENDER AND IN WHOLE-HEARTED WORSHIP OF JESUS.
