SUDAN cont.

 WR provides WASH and protection services to 8,300 refugees in Camp 6 (Wad El Mahi -Blue Nile state) and is the sole provider of water. Access to the camp has been limited only because of the ongoing conflict and a strike by the Government of Sudan. The armed conflict erupted in Wad El Mahi itself, but has since spread to Damazine, the capital of Blue Nile and where our offices are located. Our staff remain unharmed, but our ability to provide services, especially in Camp 6, is limited. Please pray for safety and resumed access to our program participants.

UKRAINE

 Pray for Robert as he travels to Romania to begin his assignment as our Ukraine response coordinator — and for the people of Ukraine, that peace will prevail and that this war will come to an end.

UNITED STATES

- Pray for the world to overcome the socioeconomic crisis of COVID-19, pray for those who mourn for those they lost during the crisis.
- Continue to pray for the many refugees and other arrivals who have come to the U.S. from Afghanistan, Ukraine and other countries in the last year. Also, pray specifically for the underlying conflicts in those countries. Pray for peace in those countries and the friends and family members of our clients and staff in those countries.
