

VoxYouth Retreat FAQ's

- 1. What does the cost of the retreat cover?**

The cost of the retreat covers each individual for their stay at the camp, meals, activities, and use of the facilities.
- 2. If I can't afford the entire cost, are there scholarships available?**

Yes. Click on "fill out this application" under Financial Aid and fill out your request form and someone from your campus will get back to you as soon as possible.
- 3. Who is the retreat for?**

The retreat is for students grades 7th-12th. Feel free to invite your neighbors, friends, and family members as well.
- 4. Will Vox provide transportation?**

Yes, we will be leaving from the Branford/Hartford church offices. Please note in your registration which office you be leaving from. We will be taking a combination of school buses and 15 passenger vehicles.
- 5. What time should I arrive?**

Arrival time on Friday night is between 4-4:30pm at the Hartford/Branford church offices, there will be pizza and water provided. If your student would prefer or require a different option, please provide food for them.
- 6. What if I have food allergies?**

Dietary restrictions will be accounted for in the registration process and the camp will be notified in advance of all dietary needs. Please note: To ensure your student's needs are cared for, restrictions/allergies must be noted in advance.
- 7. Can my child bring snacks?**

Yes. Due to severe allergies, all snacks must be nut free or they will be discarded.
- 8. What should I bring?**

A packing list will be sent out when you have completed your registration and again one week prior to the trip.
- 9. What are the Sleeping Arrangements?**

There will be completely separate boys and girls dorms with rooms which accommodate up to 10 people. Each dorm comes equipped with bathrooms, showers, and bunk beds. Students will need to bring a pillow and bedding for a twin mattress or a sleeping bag and pillow. Room assignments will be based off current grade levels.
- 10. What is the cell phone policy?**

Leaders will collect phones upon arrival at camp. In the case of an emergency, please contact one of the youth staff who will help you get connected to your child.
